We understand that this process can seem quite overwhelming, but we are here to help make this as easy as possible for both you and your student. The few easy steps listed below will help take all of the guess work out of this process and get your student on the road to becoming a licensed driver.

STEP 1-

Register your Portage Lakes Career Center student with Myers Driving School. The "Student Type" you will register your student for is SD – Online (Behind-the-Wheel Only). Please put PLCC under comments when registering.

STEP 2-

Once registered, we will send you a welcome letter with your link and code to register for online classes, instructions on how to do so, and details pertaining to the program.

STEP 3-

Once your student has completed their classes, a Certificate of Completion will be emailed to them. Simply send this certificate to the email address found in your welcome letter and your student will be placed on the list to begin their behind-the-wheel instruction.

STEP 5-

Portage Lakes Career Center will schedule your student for their four 2-hour behind-the-wheel lessons based on their availability to drive throughout the school day and an instructor will be assigned to them. Upon completion, the student will receive their 32-Hour Driver's Education Certificate of Completion.

STEP 6-

Schedule your student's driving exam at: www.ohiodrivingtest.com (Remember that students must have their permit for 6-months and complete 50 hours of driving, (10 must be done at night), with a legal parent or guardian prior to testing, and use their own car for testing.)
