CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGIES

BUILDING TRADES

Building Trades students learn the fundamentals of residential construction, maintenance, repair, and remodeling of homes. Students in this program should enjoy working outdoors in different weather conditions and will have the opportunity to master skills like: layout and roughing-in of a house, wiring and plumbing a house to code, masonry foundation and concrete work, drywall and finish carpentry, setting windows and hanging doors, painting, roofing, and siding installation. Students also learn how to operate the following construction site equipment: skid steer; excavator; telehandler; boom lift; and scissor lift.

WELDING TECHNOLOGY


